...the premises, the following procedure will be used:



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Indoor athletic contest – principal, athletic administrator, AD and head coaches will meet at designated location (AD's office) for briefing on situation. Students and spectators will be directed out of their nearest exit (East side 2 back exit doors and southeast entrance door or evacuate through community room entrance). Spectators will be directed by police of fire personnel on driving routes.

Outdoor athletic contest – principal, athletic administrator, AD and head coaches will meet at Nearest and safest location for briefing on situation. Athletes (football field) will retreat to portable locker rooms or REACH! Partnership School. If contest is on Harford Rd., athletes will return to REACH! Partnership through main office entrance. Spectators will be directed by school police and or school personnel to safely vacate the premises and wait for further instructions

6. Other Emergency Provision Required by the Coach:

- A. Review emergency plans with team captains and other reliable athletes to make them aware of their responsibilities in the case of medical or other emergencies.
- B. Who will call emergency personnel? Any certified coach or parent
- C. Who will stay with the athlete? Coaches and/or parent
- D. Who will go with the athlete to the hospital if necessary? Parent/Coach/or Designee
- E. Always have medical cards on hand with pertinent information included.
- F. Principal (or Designee) assigned to complete the Student Accident eForm (within 24 hours) and email a prints screen to Tara I. Seaton (tseaton@bcps.k12.md.us) in the Office of Interscholastic Athletics (at the start of the next school day)
