



FINAL Class Contract for c/o 2026 (April 2026)

Purpose: This contract outlines the expectations and requirements for participating in all Senior Activities (including prom, senior class trip, inauguration, farewell and any other senior event).

Eligibility Requirements:

To participate in senior events, students **must meet all the following criteria:**

- **Attendance:** Maintain **at least 80% attendance** throughout the school year
- **Academics:** Must be **passing all classes** they are enrolled in
- **Behavior:** **No suspensions** during the 2025-2026 school year
- **Payments:** Senior dues must be paid **in full** ASAP.
- **Graduation:** Must be on track to graduate and have met ALL MSDE graduation requirements
 - Grades, state testing , SSL hours, BCPSS issued technology returned

Failure to meet these expectations may result in **loss of senior privileges and participation** in class events.

Payments: ALL monies collected for senior dues are to be given to Ms. Michelle Smith ONLY in room 132A/B. NO other advisor or staff member collects money other than Ms. Smith. Payments are only received in cash or money order and made out to REACH! Partnership HS C/o 2026. Students and parents, please keep all receipts for dues payment.

All senior dues are to be paid in full NO LATER than April 20, 2026. No exceptions.

Attention Prom attendees and Parents: For the safety and comfort of all guests, REACH! Partnership has established the following prom contract. Please read the following information carefully.

Cost for outside student guest ticket: \$50.00 (cash or money order made out to REACH! Partnership)

No guest permitted over the age of 21. No guest permitted under 16.

One (1) outside guest per REACH! Student

Parents/Guardians are not permitted inside the prom venue

NO dues or guest fees will be accepted after April 20, 2026.

Dress Code

Female attire must adhere to the following requirements when considering dresses:

- Formal Attire – strapless and spaghetti straps are permitted
- Your breasts should not be exposed – cleavage with no more than 2 inches showing
- Dresses should not reveal more than 5 inches of leg above the knee
- Dresses should not be so tight as to prevent movement or show the bottom of the gluteal area (buttocks). No jeans, sweatpants, tracksuits or athletic wear
- Shoes must be worn at all times (bring a second, more comfortable pair of shoes)
- Dresses that are sheer and reveal undergarments are NOT PERMITTED

Male attire must adhere to the following requirements when considering attire:

- Formal Attire – dress pants, button up shirt and tie, suit or tuxedo
- Shirts must always remain on and buttoned
- No Jeans, sweatpants, tracksuits or athletic wear **and** shoes must be worn at all times
- No baseball type hats, bandanas/du-rags or large chains

For any attire, NO graphics, images or lettering that is vulgar or shows images/words of sex, drugs/alcohol and/or derogatory comments or images.

ALL PERSONAL PROPERTY IS THE SOLE RESPONSIBILITY OF THE PROM ATTENDEE. REACH PARTNERSHIP AND MARTINS WEST ARE NOT RESPONSIBLE FOR ANY LOST, STOLEN OR DAMAGED STUDENT PROPERTY.

REACH! Partnership administration will determine any prom dress code violation(s) and entry may be denied if attire is deemed inappropriate or if prom attendees choose not to comply. Dress code rules are in place for the duration of prom. Altering attire once in the venue will result in removal from the prom.

Prom attendees who are unsure if their attire meets the above dress code are encouraged to see a junior or senior advisor for approval.

All prom attendees are subject to a search of coats, jackets, suits and purses before entering the prom venue. Failure to be searched will result in refusal of entry into the prom venue. Parents/guardians are not permitted in to the prom venue. Any illegal substance (drugs, tobacco/vapes, alcohol and weapon(s)) will be confiscated and will deny student(s) of entry into the venue.

Outside photographers and entourages are not permitted in the prom venue.

Due to size of the entryway into the prom venue, Prom attendees will have 2-3 minutes to have any last-minute pictures taken and be asked only once to enter or be denied entry. This gives all attendees a chance to make a grand entrance.

Behavioral Expectations

- All rules and policies of REACH! Partnership and the Baltimore City School Code of Conduct will be enforced.
- Any prom attendee who displays signs or behaviors of being under the influence or in possession of any illegal substance (alcohol, illegal drugs and/or tobacco or vape products) will be denied entry into the prom and/or removed from prom and disciplinary action taken by school administration and school or local police.
- Once students leave the event, they will not be permitted back in the prom venue
- Guest must be accompanied by the REACH! student listed above who purchased a ticket
- There will be no refunds for prom attendees that are denied entry, arrive after 9:00pm to the prom or removal from the prom.

Prom attendees that are not REACH! Partnership students MUST submit a valid school ID or government issued photo identification.

ALL outside prom guests who are school aged, MUST have their parent and school administrator complete the REACH! Prom guest approval form. School MUST stamp or emboss, or approval form will not be approved.
